An estimated 400,000 cardiac arrests happen outside the hospital with 88% of those occurring in the home. The remaining 12% of cardiac arrests occur at the workplace. Receiving CPR training could mean the difference in someone's chance at life. For every minute a victim is down, their likelihood of survival decreases 10% and carrying this life saving skill offers the potential to save an employee, co-worker, friend or loved-one. CPR increases one's chance of life double or even triple, depending on how quickly care is rendered, and adding an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) increases their chance three-fold.

CPR holds its importance as a life skill, which anyone in the community has the capacity to learn. It has often been engrained that this skill is for medical professionals, which certainly proves false. There are no prerequisites for receiving CPR training and having a medical background is not required. Many people often feel it's not their place to perform these life saving techniques, not realizing that having the knowledge to render care during an emergency might make the difference between whether a person survives or not.

Resuscicare is an authorized American Safety & Health Institute (ASHI) Training Center that offers a vast course catalog, with CPR, AED, and First Aid standing as

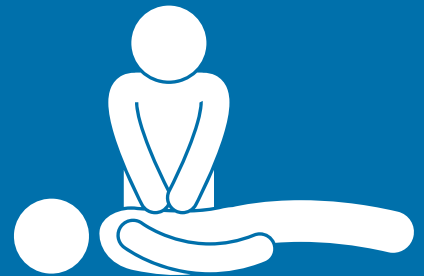
